

Academic Scholarships Years 7 and 10 Geelong Lutheran College Armstrong Creek entry 2025

As a Lutheran school providing quality Christian co-education, Geelong Lutheran College Armstrong Creek (GLC AC) is committed to recognising students' gifts and abilities, giving them opportunities to challenge and academically extend themselves.

In acknowledging God's blessings to us, GLC AC offers a limited number of Academic Scholarships to existing and prospective students who demonstrate high academic achievement and are willing to embrace the ethos of the College.

Academic Scholarships may be offered to students who are Australian citizens or permanent residents. In addition to their Scholarship requirements, all students at GLC AC are expected to actively participate in activities offered within the College.

For students sitting the Academic Scholarship for Year 7, the tenure of the Scholarship is for Years 7-12. For students sitting the Academic Scholarship for Year 10, the tenure of the Scholarship is for Years 10-12. Scholarships will be reviewed each semester by the Head of Secondary and are subject to continued excellence in academic performance and adherence to the College policies and procedures. The awarding of a scholarship and financial subsidy of each scholarship shall be determined by the Principal or delegate.

Scholarships apply to tuition fees only and do not apply to levies or other costs e.g. uniforms. Academic Scholarships provide up to half remission of tuition fees and are available to new and existing students commencing 2025.

Scholarships will be awarded on the results of the Scholarship Examination, prepared and Conducted online by Edutest, on Saturday 10 February 2024, at 10 am. The test provides reliable information on performance across a range of achievement factors focused on three areas of Reading comprehension, written expression and Mathematics.

All Scholarship candidates not already enrolled at the College must complete an enrolment application at the College prior to registering for the Scholarship Examination. For more information, please visit https://www.glc.vic.edu.au/enrolments/enrolment-process/

The registration fee for candidates taking the Scholarship Examination is \$130. Please complete the Edutest Academic Scholarship Registration Form online by visiting the GLC website, www.glc.vic.edu.au (Enrolments/Academic Scholarships/Edutest Registration.)

There is no refund for scholarship candidates who are absent from the examination. The registration closing date for a 2025 Academic Scholarship is Friday 2 February 2024.

An Academic Scholarship awarded by GLC AC forms a confidential arrangement between the College and the family and must not be discussed with other parties.

It is anticipated that candidates will be advised of the results towards the end of Term 1, 2024.
