

2020 Academic Scholarships Geelong Lutheran College - Armstrong Creek

As a Lutheran school providing quality Christian co-education, Geelong Lutheran College Armstrong Creek (GLC AC) is committed to recognising students' gifts and abilities, giving them opportunities to challenge and academically extend themselves.

Now that the College is 10 years old, part of our growth and journey is giving back to the community. In acknowledging God's blessings to us, GLC AC will offer a number of academic scholarships to existing and prospective students who are willing to embrace the ethos of the College.

Academic Scholarships may be offered to students who are Australian citizens or permanent residents. In addition to their Scholarship requirements, all students at GLC AC are expected to actively participate in activities offered within the College. For students sitting the Academic Scholarship for Year 7, the tenure of the Scholarship is for Years 7-12. For students sitting the Academic Scholarship for Year 10, the tenure of the Scholarship is for Years 10-12. Scholarships will be reviewed each semester by the Curriculum Coordinator and are subject to continued excellence in academic performance and adherence to the College policies and procedures. The awarding of a scholarship and financial subsidy of each scholarship shall be determined by the Head of College or delegate.

Scholarships apply to tuition fees only and do not apply to levies or other costs e.g. uniforms. An Academic Scholarship awarded by GLC AC forms a *confidential* arrangement between the College and the family and must not be discussed with other parties. Academic Scholarships providing up to half remission of tuition fees are available to new and existing students commencing Year 7 or Year 10 at GLC AC from 2020.

The Scholarship will be awarded on the results of the Scholarship Examination, prepared and conducted by Edutest, on **Saturday 9 February 2019**, at the Armstrong Creek Campus, commencing at 10 am. The Scholarship examination identifies the highest achieving students within a group of high achievers. The test provides reliable information on performance across a range of achievement factors focused on three areas of reading comprehension, written expression and mathematics.

It is essential that all Scholarship candidates not already enrolled at the College must complete an enrolment application at the College prior to registering for the Scholarship Examination. For more information, please visit https://www.glc.vic.edu.au/enrolments/enrolment-process/
