



GLC General Excellence Scholarship for Years 7 to 10

The Geelong Lutheran College General Excellence Scholarships acknowledge achievement in the any of the areas of Christian faith, Leadership, community service, talent in music, sport, performing arts or visual arts.

We invite applicants entering Years 7 to 10 who demonstrate these qualities to apply. Scholarships are open to currently enrolled and new students. We value and acknowledge students who are dedicated, motivated and engaged in a variety of experiences within school and community life.

General Excellence Scholarships provide up to a 50% reduction in tuition fees for the duration of the student's secondary education. All other fees and charges are payable in full.

Applications for 2027 open on 1 November 2025 and close at 4pm on 20 March 2026. After the closing date, applications will be reviewed and shortlisted students will be invited to the College for an interview with a member of the College Leadership team.

Documentation Requirements

Please upload the following documentation via the online application form:

- Two written character references with identified source (e.g. Music teacher, sports coach, Pastor/Minister of religion)
- Most recent School reports
- Most recent NAPLAN
- Specific information on your child's achievements in any of the following areas: Christian faith, Leadership, community service, talent in music, sport, performing arts or visual arts.
- Personal outline of achievements **written by students** (minimum two paragraphs, maximum one page).

Selection Criteria

Areas of General Excellence that Scholarships may be offered under are:

1. **Christian Life, Leadership, Community Service (one of these)**
2. **Sport**
3. **Music**
4. **Performing Arts**
5. **Visual Arts**

- General Excellence Scholars are required to contribute fully to the life of the College, making a visible and positive contribution to the culture of the College
- Students must maintain academic standards, positive learning, engagement and efforts,
- Students must meet behavioral standards and make an overall positive contribution to GLC
- Academic records denoting high levels of engagement, effort and involvement
- A passion and commitment to their chosen area of excellence.

Scholarship Conditions

- General Excellence Scholarship applications are open to students entering Year 7 to 10 at Geelong Lutheran College in 2027. This includes external students with an application for 2027 enrolment in the system and currently enrolled Geelong Lutheran College students. The following students are not eligible to apply:
 - International students requiring a student visa to study within Australia
 - Current GLC students with an active scholarship
- General Excellence Scholarship applications are to be submitted online via the General Excellence Scholarship online form
- Applicants who are shortlisted will be invited to attend an interview with a member of the College Leadership team
- General Excellence Scholarships offer a reduction **up to 50%** off the tuition fees, for the duration of the student's secondary education. All other fees and charges are payable in full
- GLC reserves the right not to offer a Scholarship, or to withdraw an existing scholarship, if the standard of those presenting does not comply with the expectations of the College
- Annual reviews of the Scholarship will be conducted to verify satisfactory progress and participation. In exceptional circumstances, the Scholarship may be terminated
- It is our expectation that recipients of the General Excellence Scholarship will complete their Secondary Education at GLC. The College reserves the right to ask for reimbursement to the value of the Scholarship if the student leaves the College prior to completion of Year 12
- If a General Scholarship is offered to a new family, payment of the Enrolment deposit of \$500 will be payable within 7 days to confirm the offer
- Offers are for commencement in Term 1 of the following year
- The closing date for applications is 4pm on Friday 20 March 2026. Late applications will not be accepted
- Successful applicants will be notified via email.
